STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

On the 29 day of June, 2011, between Larry Gordon, Respondent and William J. Colquhoun, Staff Counsel, agreed as follows:

STIPULATIONS

1. The State Ethics Commission ("Commission") is an executive agency of the State of Maryland established for the purpose of enforcing the Maryland Public Ethics Law (Title 15, State Government Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, hereinafter "the Ethics Law").
2. The Respondent timely registered as a lobbyist with the State Ethics Commission on behalf of Land Fair Properties, LLC (T/A Reliable Properties) ("the employer") for the period of November 1, 2010 through October 31, 2011 as required by § 15-703(d)(1) of the Ethics Law.
3. The Respondent was required to submit a Lobbying Activity Report by May 31, 2011, for the period November 1, 2010 through April 30, 2011, as required by § 15-704(a)(i) of the Ethics Law, and failed to submit the required report in a timely manner.
4. On June 16, 2011, the Respondent submitted the delinquent Lobbying Activity Report for the period November 1, 2010 through April 30, 2011.
5. On June 15, 2011, the Commission issued a complaint against the Respondent alleging the failure to file, by May 31, 2011, a Lobbying Activity Report for the period of November 1, 2010 through April 30, 2011.
6. The Respondent is voluntarily entering into this Stipulation of Settlement Agreement to admit his failure to timely file the Lobbying Activity Report for the period November 1, 2010 through April 30, 2011 and to pay a sum of money in lieu of potential late filing fees and fines that could be assessed pursuant to § 15-405 of the Ethics Law.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the agreements herein contained and effective on the Commission's acceptance of the terms of this Agreement, Larry Gordon, Respondent, and William J. Colquhoun, Staff Counsel agree as follows:

- A. Respondent admits that he did not timely file his Lobbying Activity Report on behalf of the employer for the period November 1, 2010 through April 30, 2011 by May 31, 2011, in violation of § 15-704(a)(ii) of the Ethics Law.
- B. Respondent subsequently filed the required Lobbying Activity Report with the Commission (a copy of which has been attached hereto and made a part hereof).
- C. Respondent understands that failure to comply with the lobbying disclosure provisions of the Ethics Law may subject him to the possibility of late fees, civil fines, reprimand, a suspension of his ability to lobby for compensation and other penalties. Respondent acknowledges that he has been advised that the filing deadlines for activity reports are May 31st for the period of November 1st to April 30th and November 30th for the period May 1st through October 31st if he is registered in those reporting periods. Respondent also acknowledges that future late filed activity reports could be viewed as knowing and willful violations of the Ethics Law.
- D. Based on the facts stated in this Stipulation of Settlement, the Respondent agrees to pay as settlement of the complaint, the amount of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) at the time of the execution of this agreement in lieu of potential late fees and in lieu of civil fines for the above admitted late activity report (paragraph 1).
- E. Respondent waives a formal hearing on this matter and agrees that acceptance of the Stipulation of Settlement by the Commission would constitute, based on his admission of violations of the Ethics Law, a final action and finding of violation by the Commission, and, pursuant to § 15-407 of the Ethics Law, this Agreement and materials relating to this matter are not subject to the confidentiality provisions of the Ethics Law and will be public information unless otherwise protected.
- F. Staff Counsel, upon execution of this Agreement by the Respondent, will recommend that the Commission suspend further complaint proceedings against the Respondent and recommend further that the Commission issue a Final Order in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.
- G. The agreement, including any documents incorporated herein, and the Final Order will be transmitted to the employer.

H. Respondent and Staff Counsel have entered into this Agreement for the sole purpose of resolving the late submission of the Lobbying Activity Report, the payment in lieu of late fees and fines, to resolve the complaint now pending, and for no other purpose.

IN WITNESS WHEREFORE, Larry Gordon, Respondent and William J. Colquhoun, Staff Counsel for the State Ethics Commission, have signed below.

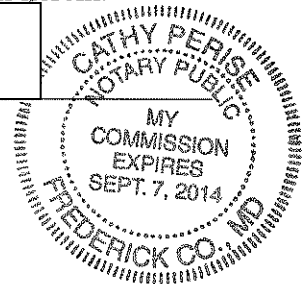

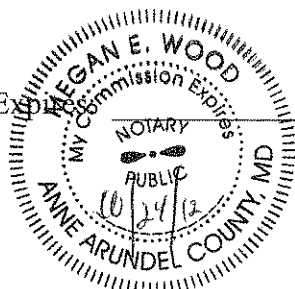

Dear Mr. Colquhoun,

We are writing to you on behalf of Employer, Land Fair Properties, LLC, and Lawrence Shulman, Larry Gordon, and Anne Marie Vassallo (the “Lobbyists”). The Lobbyists each received correspondence from Robert A. Hahn, Executive Director of the State Ethics Commission, dated June 15, 2011 regarding the Commission’s Complaint pursuant to § 15-401(b) of the Maryland Public Ethics Law (Maryland Code Annotated, State Government Articles, Title 15 (Supp. 2010)). The Complaints allege the failure of the Lobbyists to timely file on or before May 31, 2011 the Activity Report for period ending April 30, 2011 of Land Fair Properties, LLC with the Commission.

We would like it noted that Activity Reports were forwarded to the State Ethics Commission for each of the Lobbyists by Federal Express on June 14, 2011. Further, email notice was received by each Lobbyist of the Commission’s acceptance of the Activity Reports on June 16, 2011.

The Lobbyists offer to you for your consideration that the Activity Reports were not timely filed due to a recent conversion of our accounting/billing system. This conversion and system downtime did not allow us to compute the compensation required for reporting. As soon as the conversion was complete *and* operational, we prepared the Activity Reports and filed them with the Ethics Commission. Since the accounting/billing system is now operational and running smoothly, we do not anticipate any further issues relating to this matter.

Further, we understand the Commission’s position in issuing the Complaint, however we kindly request that no sanctions or suspension of our lobbying registration be issued. We regret the untimely filing and ask that you take into account that all previously filed Activity Reports have been timely and this is the first complaint the Firm has received since its registration in January 2006.
