*Pursuant to §5-903(a)(2) of the Maryland Public Ethics Law (Md. Code Ann., Gen'l Prov. Title 5 (2025)), a person that knowingly and willfully violates §5.501.1(E) of the Law is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$10,000 or imprisonment not exceeding 1 year or both. Pursuant to §5-903(b) of the Maryland Public Ethics Law, if the person is not an individual, each officer or partner who knowingly authorizes or participates in violation of §5.501.1(E) is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to the penalty specified in §5-903(a) referenced above.*
